- (a) the district-wise number of warehouses currently operating in Rajasthan for the storage of foodgrains along with the number of warehouses belonging to SFCI and rented warehouses;**
- (b) the number of farmers being benefitted from the said warehouses;**
- (c) whether the Government has examined that these warehouses are adequate for the procurement of foodgrains from farmers in Rajasthan;**
- (d) the reaction of the Government thereto;**
- (e) the quantum of foodgrains rotting/getting spoiled every year; and**
- (f) the number of more warehouses proposed to be set up or leased for storage in Rajasthan?**

- (a): The details of district-wise number of warehouses currently operating in Rajasthan by Food Corporation of India (FCI) is at Annexure-I.**
  - (b): 2,19,853 farmers were benefitted from Minimum Support Price (MSP) for wheat procurement in Rajasthan during Rabi Market Season (RMS) 2020-21.**

**(c)&(d): As per trend of procurement during last 05 years, the storage capacity available in Rajasthan is adequate for storage of procured foodgrains from farmers.**

**(e): Foodgrain available with FCI is stored and preserved scientifically. FCI is storing/ handling large quantities of foodgrains for the purpose of issuance/distribution under National Food Security Act (NFSA) and other welfare schemes of Government of India.**

**Out of these Stocks, very small quantity of food grains get damaged mainly due to Natural Calamities like Cyclone/Flood & transit damages viz. en-route damage in wagon/truck due to contamination, wagon roof leakage etc. In some cases, due to negligence of officials/officers, for which suitable disciplinary action are invariably taken against defaulters.**

**Statement showing State-wise quantum of foodgrains rotting (damaged) during the last 3 years and current year including Rajasthan is at Annexure-II.**

**(f): FCI continuously assesses and monitors the storage capacity and based on the storage gap assessment, storage capacities are created/hired in the country including Rajasthan.**
