(a) to (d): Indian Railways, through IRCTC and various State tourism development corporations, caters to the demand of diverse tourism segments, ranging from budget to luxury segments. Budget segment packages are offered through Bharat Darshan/Aastha Circuit/Pilgrim Specials. The semi-luxury segment is catered by Buddhist AC Specials. Luxury segment tourism packages include Maharajas Express, Deccan Odyssey, Palace on Wheels and Golden Chariot trains which are connecting major tourist destinations of the country.

During the last three years, the different segments of tourist trains operated are as under:
