- (a) whether the National Statistical Office has released the Employment Outlook of the country covering the period from September, 2017 to December, 2020 based on the administrative records available with selected Government agencies to assess the progress;

(a) to (c): Yes Sir. The Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation has been bringing out the formal sector employment related statistics through monthly press release covering period from September 2017 onwards using information on the number of subscribers who have subscribed in three major schemes, namely the Employees' Provident Fund (EPF) Scheme, the Employees' State Insurance (ESI) Scheme and the National Pension Scheme (NPS) since April, 2018.

The number of new subscribers who have joined the Employees' Provident Fund (EPF), Employees' State Insurance (ESI), National Pension Scheme (NPS) from September, 2017 to December, 2020 were 394.11 lakh, 463.21 lakh and 23.61 lakh respectively.
