INDUSTRIES IN BIHAR

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state: वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री

- (a) whether the Union Government is working on any scheme to set up industries in Bihar;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of industries set up in Bihar during the last five years, locationwise along with the current status of functional industries;
- (d) whether these industries are in profit;
- (e) if so, whether the profit earned by such industries has been utilised to establish more industries; and
- (f) if not, the steps taken to bail out such industries?

ANSWER

वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री सोम प्रकाश) THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

(a) to (f): Government of India has been continuously endeavoring to put in place measures for expanding industries in India. The intent has been to enhance industrialization keeping in mind the national interest and removing policy bottlenecks that have been hindering the investment inflows into the country.

However, the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) has not currently developed any scheme for setting up of industries specifically for the state of Bihar. Further, since this Department deals with policy matters related to Industries, it does not maintain any centralized data on the number and location of industries set up in a particular state. The matters related to industrialization of a specific state are dealt by that state only as Industries is a state subject.
