RESUMPTION OF TRAIN OPERATIONS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of various categories of passenger trains, express trains, mail, superfast and MEMU train services which were running in the country before lock down, zone and division-wise;
- (b) the number of special trains that started running again after lockdown;
- (c) whether these trains contain unreserved general class coaches;
- (d) if so, the time by when the remaining trains are likely to resume their operations as before the lockdown period;
- (e) whether stoppages at several railway stations have been removed during the resumption of the operation of the trains, if so, the details and the reasons therefor; and
- (f) the details of the railway stations/trains on which the stoppages have been removed after resumption of the operation of trains, divisionwise?

(a) and (b) Trains on Indian Railways are operated on Zonal Railways' ownership basis. The zone-wise details of average daily number of trains operated during pre-COVID period and that being operated presently is tabulated below:

- (c) The Special trains presently being operated do have unreserved coaches in their composition. However, in view of pandemic situation, unreserved second class in long distance Mail/Express trains, has been declared as reserved second class.
- (d) to (f) To prevent the spread of COVID-19 pandemic, Indian Railways discontinued all regular passenger carrying trains w.e.f. 23rd March, 2020 and presently only special trains, with limited stoppages, keeping in view the suggestions and concerns of the State Governments are being operated. The numbers of services are being increased in a phased manner and as on 19th March, 2021, Indian Railways has started operation of a total of 8634 train services which includes 2402 Mail/Express trains and 851 Passenger trains. Besides, Indian Railways is keeping a close watch on the situation by regularly monitoring the waiting list, undertaking temporary augmentation, operating clone train (wherever required) and is resuming train services in a phased manner keeping in view the health protocols and feedback from the States.
