Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of railway stations where CCTV cameras have been installed as per the budgetary announcement;
- (b) the State-wise details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to use these cameras to prevent the entry of unauthorised persons into the passenger reservation centres of railways ticket area; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF RAILWAYS, COMMERCE & INDUSTRY AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

- (a) & (b) Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Cameras have been provided at 686 stations. State wise details are appended.
- (c) & (d) Online monitoring through Close Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras is done at Passenger Reservation centre as well as other areas of major railway stations. If any unlawful/suspicious activity is observed, immediate action is taken. Presently prevention of entry of persons is not done by using CCTV monitoring. However, surveillance on persons indulging in suspicious /objectionable activities is maintained and intervention is made as and when the need arises.
