- (b) whether on the coach S12 on train 16232 which departed from Karur on 02/09/2017, there was no TTE on board between Karur and Kumbakonam;
- (c) if so, the details in this regard;
- (d) the status of reserved passengers, if the train was not manned;
- (e) whether there is any rule in the Railways that allows reserved coaches to be left unmanned; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?
