Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government had earmarked Rs. 450 crores for the cluster development programme during 2017-18 to 2020-21, and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government intends to continue earmarking funds for the cluster development programme, and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of employment generated at each cluster during the last three years, State-wise;
- (d) whether the Government intends to prioritise cluster development in certain industries to create export hubs and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether there are proposals to operationalise developed clusters in Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof, district-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NITIN GADKARI)

- (a): Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) earmarked Rs. 184.00 crores, Rs. 279.00 crores, Rs. 227.90 crores and Rs. 390.69 crores for the year 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 respectively under "Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP)".
- (b): Budget Estimate for 2021-22 is Rs. 156.50 crores under MSE-CDP.
- (c): Under MSE-CDP, Common Facility Centre is set up for enhancing the productivity and competitiveness as well as capacity building of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs). Job creation in the cluster depends on various factors such as aggregate domestic & global demand, seasonality etc. in and around the clusters.
- (d): MSE-CDP is a demand driven scheme and proposals are received through respective State Governments duly recommended by them.
- (e): 13 Common Facility Centres (CFCs) and 5 Infrastructure Development (ID) projects have been completed in Maharashtra under MSE-CDP. District-wise details are enclosed at **Annexure**.
