**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-**

- a) whether the Union Government's PM Street Vendors Atma Nirbhar Nidhi Scheme which aims to empower the poor people has been renamed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh as 'Jagananna Todu';**
- b) if so, the details thereof;**
- c) whether some other schemes of the Union Government have also been renamed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof; and**
- d) the manner in which this usurping / renaming of Central schemes by States is observed by the Union Government?**
