- (a) to (c) The Green Highways (Plantation, Transplantation, Beautification & Maintenance) Policy, 2015 covers all the National Highways of the country with the aim to promote greening of corridors. Under the policy, 199.78 lakh plants have been planted across 728 NH projects having length of 42,969 kms.
- (d) The local indigenous, non-invasive shrubs and ornamental as well as non-ornamental shade bearing trees suitable for different agro climatic zones are planted as per the Indian Road Congress' guideline (IRC SP:21-2009).
