### FUNDS FOR DRINKING WATER AVAILABILITY IN BIHAR

†4887: SHRI MAHABALI SINGH:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has allocated/released/utilised any funds for making drinking water available to Bihar during the last three years;
- (b) whether the State Government of Bihar has not apprised the Union Government of works undertaken regarding potable water;
- (c) the reaction of the Union Government thereto;
- (d) the rules relating to submission of progress report by the State Government to the Union Government regarding providing potable water;
- (e) whether the Government of Bihar is complying with the same;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA)

(a) After subsuming erstwhile National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), since August, 2019, Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal, to make provision of assured potable tap water supply to every rural household by 2024. The details of allocation, release and reported expenditure of the Central fund in Bihar under JJM in 2019-20, and under erstwhile NRDWP in 2017-18 and 2018-19, are as under:
