- (a) the number of inter-State road connectivity projects amongst the States of Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Uttar Pradesh lying incomplete at present;**
- (b) the time by which the said project are likely to be completed;**
- (c) whether the Government has provided financial assistance to the State Governments for the construction of inter-State bridges and roads which are economically important; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof ?**

- (a) to (b) All inter-State road connectivity projects amongst the States of Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal and Uttar Pradesh have been completed.**
- (c) to (d) Government provided financial assistance to the State Government for construction of inter-State bridges and roads as per CRIF Act,2000 and its subsequent amendments. Ministry has recently sanctioned Panduka Bridge across river Sone to provide Inter-state connectivity between Bihar and Jharkhand.**
