- (a) the details and the present status of Amritsar-Jamnagar Green Expressway being constructed under the Bharatmala Pariyojana;
- (b) the estimated expenditure likely to be incurred thereon along with the time limit fixed for completion of the said project;
- (c) whether any challenges are being faced by the Government in execution of the said project and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details and the present status of other roads linked with Bharatmala Pariyojana in Rajasthan?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Amritsar-Jamanager Economic Corridor is included in Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I for development. Total length of this corridor is 1,225 km (917 km Greenfield and 308 km Brownfield) in the State of Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan and Gujarat. Total estimated capital cost of the development of Amritsar-Jamanager Economic Corridor is Rs. 27,560 crore. The road works (except in the stretch from Amritsar to Bathinda of 155 km) have been awarded and are in different stages of implementation with target for by Year 2023-24. Government is facing difficulties completion implementation of Sangariya-Santalpur Greenfield Corridor in the State of Rajasthan due to delay in the acquisition and possession of land specifically in Hanumangarh, Bikaner and Jalore districts. Total 44 road projects comprising length of 2,138 kms have been envisaged for development under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I in the State of Rajasthan, out of which 40 projects of 1,887 kms have been awarded.
