(a) to (b) 6 National Highways (NHs) such as NE-5 (Delhi-Amritsar-Katra Expressway), NE-5A (Amritsar connectivity to Delhi-Katra Expressway), NH-503D (Beas to Dera Baba Nanak), NH-754A (Amritsar-Bathinda), NH-205K (Ludhiana- Roopnagar and spur to Kharar) and NH-754AD (Ludhiana – Bathinda) covering a length of about 804 km with estimated cost of Rs. 36,000 crore have been identified for upgradation to 4/6 laning in the State of Punjab.
