WORK ON BRIDGES AND FLYOVERS

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सडक परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and the present status of work of flyovers on National Highways (NHs) in Gopalganj district and the time frame set for their completion;
- (b) whether it is a fact that 0.8 km Dumaria Ghat Bridge and 1.866 km Flyover in Gopalganj town which were scheduled for completion within two years after award of work are yet to be started even after a lapse of two years and if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) whether the maintenance works on all service roads of NHs in Gopalganj district are yet to be started and if so, the details thereof along with the time frame set for the purpose?

(a) & (b) Earlier, this stretch was awarded, and had to be terminated due to failure of Contractor to complete the work. Presently, Tender documents for the work of Dumaria Ghat Bridge on Gandak River as well as flyover in Gopalganj town are at final stage. Fresh tender shall be invited by June, 2021 with scheduled completion period of two years from date of award.

(c) Maintenance of service road in Gopalganj district has been completed in the month of December, 2020 and traffic is moving smoothly.
