(a): At present there is no proposal under consideration for preservation of Parsi shrines in Pakistan. However, visits by Pilgrims from India and Pakistan to mutually agreed list of religious shrines in each other's country are facilitated under the "Bilateral Protocol on Visits to Religious Shrines" signed in September 1974.
