(c) whether any of the arrested persons having terminal illness, have been hospitalized and if so, the action taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b): The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has so far arrested 16

accused persons in the Bhima Koregaon Case. NIA has filed charge sheet

against 21 accused persons so far in the competent court of law.

(c): One of the accused persons viz. Varavara Rao has been admitted in

Nanavati Super Specialty Hospital, Mumbai.
