- (a) the details and the present status of four-laning work on Prayagraj-Lucknow National Highway (NH);
- (b) the funds allocated and released for the purpose; and
- (c) the time frame set for completion of the project?

- (a) to (c) The Prayagraj to Lucknow stretch consists of two sections
- (i) Lucknow to Raebareli & (ii) Raebareli to Prayagraj. At present Lucknow to Raebareli section of NH-24B has been awarded on BOT (Annuity) with total project cost of Rs. 635.90 crore and is 4-laned. The physical progress in Raebareli to Prayagraj section has been awarded on BOT (Toll) with total project cost of Rs. 499.93 crore. The progress work is 98%. 4-lane work on Lucknow to Raebareli section was completed on 14.04.2015. The expected date of completion of 2-

lane + PS work of Raebareli to Prayagraj Section is 31.03.2021.
