- (a) the names of the districts proposed to be connected with the National Highways under the Bharatmala Pariyojana in Uttar Pradesh, Phase-1 and Phase-2; and
- (b) the details of the works done so far in this regard; and
- (c) the funds released and utilized for the purpose?

(a) About 51 districts (Kanpur, Fatehpur, Kaushambi, Baghpat,
Shamli, Saharanpur, Meerut, Muzaffarnagar, Aligarh, Hathras, Etah,
Mainpuri, Moradabad, Amroha, Hapur, Kannauj, Bijnor, Unnao,
Raebareli, Hamirpur, Mahoba, Agra, Bareilly, Pilibhit, Kasganj,
Budaun, Lakhimpur Kheri, Shahjahanpur, Hardoi, Lucknow,
Barabanki, Bahraich, Prayagraj, Bhodohi, Mirzapur, Varanasi,

Sultanpur, Pratapgarh, Jaunpur, Azamgarh, Ghazipur, Chandauli, Gorakhpur, Mau, Ayodhya, Basti, Sant kabir Nagar, Deoria, Kushinagar, Maharajganj, Pratapgarh) are proposed to be connected with National Highways under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I in the State of Uttar Pradesh. There is no approved Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-II.

(b) Projects of length 1624 km have been awarded till January, 2021 in the State of Uttar Pradesh. Out of which, 462 km length has been completed.

(c) About Rs. 1,05,000 crores were released for construction as well as land acquisition. Out of which, about Rs. 93,000 crores were utilized.
