## AIRPORT IN DARBHANGA

## 654. SHRI GOPAL JEE THAKUR

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

(a) whether Darbhanga airport in Bihar is the most successful airport under the UDAN scheme and if so, the details thereof; and

(b) whether the Government proposes to develop Darbhanga airport as an international airport and if so, the details thereof?

## **ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Darbhanga was one of the significant unserved airports which have now been covered under the Regional Connectivity Scheme-UDAN. The Implementing Agency, Airports Authority of India (AAI), awarded routes from Darbhanga connecting to Delhi, Bangalore and Mumbai in 2nd round of bidding under UDAN to the Selected Airline Operator (SAO). UDAN flights have been commenced by the SAO on 8.11.2020.

Under UDAN, as many as 64,238 passengers have travelled on 369 flights operated in two months after the commencement of flights from Darbhanga airport. At present, there is no proposal to develop Darbhanga as an international airport.
