COVID-19 VACCINATION IN TAMIL NADU

709. SHRI A. RAJA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of COVID-19 vaccine supplied, vaccination programme/session conducted in the State of Tamil Nadu, district-wise;
- (b) the number of beneficiaries vaccinated thereof;
- (c) whether large number of adverse effects are reported post COVID-19 vaccination in the country, especially in Tamil Nadu, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the details of the number of persons suffered post COVID vaccination and hospitalized; and
- (e) the details of the steps taken by the Government to bear the hospitalization cost of such people?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a): A total of 12.34 lakh doses of COVID-19 vaccines have been supplied to the State of Tamil Nadu. The district-wise detail of vaccine distribution is at Annexure 1.

Till 2nd February 2021, a total of 3,634 vaccination sessions have been conducted in the State of Tamil Nadu. The district-wise details is at Annexure-2

- (b): A total of 1,20,745 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the State of Tamil Nadu till 02nd February 2021. The district-wise details is at Annexure-2
- (c): A total of 7,580 Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI) have been reported following COVID-19 vaccination, of which 42 AEFIs have been reported from Tamil Nadu. Majority of these AEFIs are minor in nature like pain at injection site, fever, malaise etc.
- (d): A total of 22 hospitalizations have been reported following COVID-19 vaccination till 2nd February 2021.
- (e): All States and UTs have been advised to provide free medical care at public health care facilities to all cases of AEFIs.
