BAN ON TOBACCO PRODUCTS

768. DR. A. CHALLAKUMAR:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the steps taken by the Government to ban the use of tobacco products and spitting in public places amid COVID-19;

(b) the details of ban on the sale, use and spitting of tobacco products hookkah bars amid COVID-19 in the country, State/UT-wise;

(c) whether the Government has any proposal to bring amendment in COTPA 2003 to bring about provisions to ban hookkah accros the nation; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (d): Public Health being a State subject, the primary responsibility for regulation of tobacco products to reduce harm due to tobacco use, lies with the respective States/UT governments, apart from implementation of the provisions of Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) (COTPA), 2003 and the Rules made thereunder.

In view of COVID-19 pandemic, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India has issued advisories/directives to States/UTs, to take necessary measures to prevent the use and spitting of chewing smokeless tobacco products in public.

As per information received from 25 States/UTs, the State/UT-wise details of ban on the sale, use and spitting of tobacco products hookah bars amid COVID-19 in the country is at **Annexure**.

Section-4 of the COTPA, 2003, prohibits smoking in a public place including through use of hookah.

States of Bihar, Delhi, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Punjab, Rajasthan, Odisha, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand have issued explicit Notifications/orders/advisory to prohibit hookah bars.
