The Documentation has been published by the Council as a book entitled "Marmacikitsa – Basic Tenets in Ayurveda and Therapeutic Approaches" which was released by Ministry of AYUSH on the 7th of January 2021 at Regional Ayurveda Research Institute, Jhansi.
