**Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of films preaching educative values to children produced in the country during the last two years;
- (b) the number of feature films produced during the same period; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to promote and enhance the number of production of such films?

**(a) & (b) Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has produced a total of 19 films preaching educative values to children during the last two years. Amongst these 19 films, there is one feature film produced during the same period.**

**(c) Ministry of Information & Broadcasting has three dedicated schemes for promotion and production of Children's Films. These schemes are 'Production of Children's Films', 'Exhibition of Children's Films in Schools' and 'Organization of National / International Children's Film Festival'. These schemes are implemented by the funding provided by Ministry of Information and Broadcasting in the form of Grant-in-Aid to Children's Film Society, India.**
