Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has started "Atal Pension Yojana (APY)" with an objective to provide lifetime pension to the workers of unorganized sector and labourers; and
- (b)the total number of APY accounts opened in Odisha including Kalahandi and Nuapada districts along with the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a): In order to provide a universal social security system for all Indians, especially the poor, the under-privileged and the workers in the unorganised sector, the Government of India had introduced the Atal Pension Yojana (APY), with effect from 1st June, 2015.
- (b): As on 31.12.2020, the total number of enrolments under APY in Odisha are 10,22,751 out of which 20,143 enrolments are in Kalahandi district and 10,121 enrolments are in Nuapada district.
