SETTING UP OF NATIONAL COMMITTEE TO COMMEMORATE BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF NETAJI

964. SHRI NISITH PRAMANIK: SHRI VINOD KUMAR SONKAR: SHRI RAJA AMRESHWARA NAIK: SHRIMATI SANGEETA KUMARI SINGH DEO: DR. JAYANTA KUMAR ROY: SHRI BHOLA SINGH: DR. SUKANTA MAJUMDAR: WILL the MINISTER OF CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government has set up a National Committee to commemorate the 125th birth anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose ;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) Whether the National Implementation Committee has approved proposals for programmes/projects;
- (d) if so, the details thereof including funds sanctioned for programmes/projects; and
- (e) the other steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

Minister of State (I/C) for Culture & Tourism (Shri Prahlad Singh Patel)

(a) Yes Sir, Government has set up a High Level Committee to commemorate the 125th birth anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose.

(b) Government has set up a 85 member High Level Committee under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Prime Minister for commemorating the 125th birth anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose in befitting manner at national and international level. A copy of Gazette Notification issued on 8 January 2021 is enclosed.

(c) ; (d) and (e): In the very first meeting of National Implementation Committee held on 25 November, 2020, a presentation was made to the NIC regarding the themes and activities proposed on 75 years of independence by the Committee of Secretaries constituted for this purpose. Commemoration of 125th anniversary of Netaji was part of the proposed commemorations. NIC asked Ministries to dedicate/launch projects during commemoration and to communicate their action plans. Meanwhile, a preparatory meeting under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Culture Minister was held on 15th December 2020 to discuss modalities for celebration of 125th birth anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose beginning from 23rd January, 2021. The decisions/ suggestions given during preparatory meeting are to be placed before the NIC for consideration as and when next meeting of NIC takes place. In the meantime, the following projects and programs were organized by Ministry of Culture on 23rd January, 2021, to launch the commemoration (Annexure)."
