- (i) Entrepreneurship Development and Industrial Consultancy (UG)
- (ii) Fundamentals of Extension and Rural Development (UG)
- (iii) Agricultural Marketing & Price Analysis (PG)
- (iv) Market Led Extension Management (PG)

Under Post Graduate Diploma in Management (Agri Business Management) PGDM-ABM, a course titled "Contract Farming & Farmer Producer Organizations (PGDM 717)" has been offered since 2009 to students as an elective course in the second semester.
