INDIAN CITIZENS STRANDED ABROAD

*234. SHRI HIBI EDEN:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government conducted International flight operations from various foreign countries to India during the Covid pandemic era, free of cost and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the existing international flights to India are with any concession for the persons who lost their jobs, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of petitions received from Indian citizens stranded abroad, month-wise and country-wise starting from March 2020 including the details of the States to which they belong; and
- (d) whether the Government has arranged flights from foreign countries for Indian citizens stranded abroad and if so, the details of the countries and the number of flights, number of persons who travelled free of cost and the number who paid with a special focus on NRIs who have lost their jobs in Middle East as a result of Covid -19 pandemic?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (DR. SUBRAHMANYAM JAISHANKAR)

(a) to (d) A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *234 REGARDING "INDIAN CITIZENS STRANDED ABROAD" TO BE ANSWERED ON 04.08.2021.

(a) During the initial phases of the pandemic, several flights were operated by the Government of India, free of cost, for the evacuation of Indians stranded in China, Italy and Iran.

Three special flights on January 31, February 1 and February 26, 2020 were operated to evacuate 766 persons, which included 723 Indian nationals and 43 foreign nationals from the city of Wuhan as well as other cities of Hubei Province in China.

From Iran, 58 stranded Indian nationals were repatriated on 10 March 2020 by Indian Air Force's C17 Globemaster.

From Italy, two Air India special flights were arranged to evacuate 411 Indian nationals, mostly comprising of students, elderly and medically ill from Milan and Rome in March 2020.

- (b) Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, normal international travel services remain suspended. International air travel to and from India is taking place through special arrangements, including air bubbles and the Vande Bharat Mission, which are commercial in nature. Our Missions arrange for the welfare of Indian nationals, where required, including through Indian community associations. In some cases, arrangements are also made for flight tickets, boarding and lodging and emergency medical assistance under the Indian Community Welfare Fund.
- (c) to (d) A large number of requests were received by Indians nationals abroad for repatriation to India. Government of India commenced operations under the Vande Bharat Mission on May 7, 2020 to facilitate return of stranded Indian nationals abroad in a phased manner. The Vande Bharat Mission is the largest and most complex exercise ever undertaken by the government for repatriation of its nationals stranded overseas. As on 30 April'21, nearly 60 lakh people have returned under the Vande Bharat Mission, as per the information available with this Ministry. The details are at Annexure-I. The state and country wise information, as available with this Ministry is at Annexure-II.
