(b) whether the Government is considering any proposal to upgrade infrastructure facilities at Beypore port and if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether the Government has shifted Lakshadweep cargo handling facility at Beypore port to Mangalore port and if so, the reasons therefor?

(a) Major Ports are under the administrative control of Ministry of Ports, Shipping & Waterways and non-major ports are under the jurisdiction of respective State Government. Under Sagarmala Ministry is providing support to Coastal States/UTs for projects related to port infrastructure development.

(b) Yes. Government of Kerala has prepared a plan for the development of Beypore Port. It consists of following three stages:

Stage1- Capital Dredging

Stage 2- Development of Coastal Berth

Stage 3- Infrastructure and Equipment Facility Development.

(c) No. There is no shifting of Lakshadweep cargo handling facility at Beypore port to Mangalore port. The details of cargo traffic handled during 2019-20 from mainland ports to Lakshadweep is placed in Annexure - I
