STATEMENT IN RESPECT OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 253 REGARDING "CONSTRUCTION OF CIVIL AVIATION RESEARCH CENTRE" TO BE ANSWERED ON 05.08.2021

(a) and (b) Yes Sir. The Civil Aviation Research Organization (CARO) is being constructed at Begumpet Airport, Hyderabad by Airports Authority of India (AAI).

The approved cost is Rs.402.13 crore.

The facilities at CARO include as under:

i. R&D facilities for airports and Air Navigation Services (ANS)

ii. Air traffic management communications domain simulators, network emulator, visualisation and analysis labs, surveillance labs navigation systems emulation and simulation labs etc.

iii. Cyber security and threat analysis labs, data management centre, project support centre, software solutions and tools centre and network infrastructure centre.

The construction of CARO is expected to conclude by December 2023.

(c) & (d) No such proposal is currently under consideration at the Ministry of Civil Aviation.
