**PMKVY IN TAMIL NADU**

**\*287. DR. T.R. PAARIVENDHAR:**

**Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:**

- (a) the total number of youths, male and female separately, who have been enrolled from Tamil Nadu for skill development training under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) during the last three years;
- (b) the number of youths in the State, male and female separately, who have got employment or placement after the training during the last three years;
- (c) the total amount allotted and spent for this programme during the last three years;
- (d) whether the Union Government proposes to set up Skill Development Training Centres in the backward district of Perambalur in Tamil Nadu; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) to (E) of LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \*287 TO BE ANSWERED ON 09.08.2021 ASKED BY DR. T.R. PAARIVENDHAR REGARDING 'PMKVY IN TAMIL NADU'**

(a) Under the Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing its flagship scheme, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY). Under PMKVY, in the last three years (2018-21), 1.83 lakh female candidates and 1.88 lakh male candidates have been enrolled in the State of Tamil Nadu.

(b) PMKVY has two training components, namely, Short-Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). STT is linked to placement, while RPL does not mandate placements as it recognizes the existing skills of candidates. Under STT-PMKVY, in the last three years (2018-21), 1.22 lakh (0.94 lakh female and 0.28 male) candidates have been, as on 10.07.2021, certified in the State of Tamil Nadu; out of which 0.82 lakh (0.63 lakh female and 0.19 male) candidates have been placed.

(c) Under PMKVY, during the last three years (2018-21), the total budgetary allocation was Rs. 5,230.05 crore; out of which, Rs. 5,037.19 crore was disbursed to implementing agencies, i.e., the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) for Central component, and State Skill Development Mission (SSDM) / State Governments for the State component for the implementation of the PMKVY across the country including the State of Tamil Nadu.

Out of total disbursed funds in last three years (2018-21) under PMKVY, Rs. 172.43 crore (Rs. 138 crore under Central Component and Rs. 34.43 crore under State Component) was disbursed for the implementation of the scheme in the State of Tamil Nadu.

(d) Ministry promotes establishment of model and aspirational skill centre known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) for imparting skill training in every district of the country, including the district of Perambalur in the State of Tamil Nadu. Ministry through NSDC provides funding support upto 75% of the project investment for establishment of a PMKK in a district.

Also, under STT-PMKVY, training centres (TCs) are empanelled for imparting short duration training across the country, including the district of Perambalur in the State of Tamil Nadu. Under RPL-PMKVY, candidates are oriented in camps, employer premises, PMKKs and large/medium enterprises.

(e) Till now, in the State of Tamil Nadu, 35 PMKKs have been established, including 1 PMKK in the district of Perambalur. Also, under STT-PMKVY, 2,325 TCs have been empanelled in the State of Tamil Nadu, including 27 TCs in the district of Perambalur.

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
