DRINKING WATER CONNECTIONS IN ODISHA

*42. SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA:

- (a) The number of households in Odisha which have been provided with drinking water connection under Jal Jeevan Mission alongwith the number of people benefited therefrom, district-wise; and
- (b) The details of funds allocated to Odisha under the said mission, district-wise?

Statement referred to in the reply to Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 42 due for reply on 22.07.2021

(a) As on 15th August, 2019, at the time of launch of Jal Jeevan Mission, in Odisha, out of 85.67 lakh rural households, 3.11 lakh households (3.74%) had piped water connections. In the past 22 months, 23.38 lakh households have been provided tap water connections thus increasing the tap water supply to 26.49 lakh households (30.93%). The district-wise details of households which have been provided with tap water connection is at **Annex-I**.

(b) The details of Central fund allocated to Odisha under Jal Jeevan Mission in 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22, are as under:
