#### DRINKING WATER CONNECTIONS IN ODISHA

#### \*42. SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) The number of households in Odisha which have been provided with drinking water connection under Jal Jeevan Mission alongwith the number of people benefited therefrom, district-wise; and
- (b) The details of funds allocated to Odisha under the said mission, district-wise?

### Statement referred to in the reply to Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 42 due for reply on 22.07.2021

- (a) As on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2019, at the time of launch of Jal Jeevan Mission, in Odisha, out of 85.67 lakh rural households, 3.11 lakh households (3.74%) had piped water connections. In the past 22 months, 23.38 lakh households have been provided tap water connections thus increasing the tap water supply to 26.49 lakh households (30.93%). The district-wise details of households which have been provided with tap water connection is at **Annex–I.**
- (b) The details of Central fund allocated to Odisha under Jal Jeevan Mission in 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22, are as under:
