Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Kendriya Vidyalaya situated at Nasirabad Cantt in Ajmer Parliamentary Constituency was established in the year 1972;
- (b) if so, the number of students who studied in the said Vidyalaya during the last 05 years class-wise, stream-wise;
- (c) whether in view of the excess number of students in the said Kendriya Vidyalaya, the Government proposes to provide maximum benefit of proper education to local students, either by establishing an additional new Kendriya Vidyalaya or by running a second shift with inclusion of new sections in the said vidyalaya during the current academic session of 2021-22;
- (d) if so, the time by when same is likely to be done ; and
- (e) if not, the reasons and details thereof?

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. The class-wise and stream-wise number of students who studied in the Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) Nasirabad Cantt. in Ajmer Parliamentary Constituency during the last 05 years are as under:-

(c) to (e) Opening of new KVs is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-Military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education. Proposals for opening of new KVs are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations and committing resources for setting up a new KV. The proposals received from various sponsoring authorities found fulfilling the mandatory pre-requisite for opening of new KVs have to compete with other such proposals under the "Challenge Method". Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has not received any proposal for opening of additional new Kendriya Vidyalaya at Nasirabad, district Ajmer either from the State Government of Rajasthan or from the Defence Authorities.
