(a) to (e) To protect, promote and preserve various forms of art and culture including Sindhi culture throughout the country, the Government of India has set up seven Zonal Cultural Centres (ZCCs). Madhya Pradesh is a member State of North Central Zone Cultural Centre (NCZCC), Prayagraj and South Central Zone Cultural Centre, Nagpur. These ZCCs engage artists from the State of Madhya Pradesh to showcase their art/talent at Pan India level. ZCCs also implement a number of schemes viz. Award to Young Talented Artistes, Guru Shishya Parampara Scheme, Theatre Rejuvenation Scheme, Research & Documentation Scheme, Shilpgram Scheme, OCTAVE, J & K Festivals and National Cultural Exchange Programme (NCEP) for promotion of cultural development programmes in the country.

The Ministry of Culture also organizes cultural programmes like Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsavs (RSMs) & regional festivals through its Zonal Cultural Centres in various parts of the country, in which Sindhi Culture is also showcased.
