- (a) the total number of dairy farmers in the State of Madhya Pradesh who are beneficiaries of Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) or are registered thereunder;
- (b) the details of steps taken by the Government to cover the maximum number of potential beneficiaries; and
- (c) the outcome of the efforts made by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

- (a) Total 20 number applications were registered in the portal from Madhya Pradesh under Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF). Out of 20 applications, four applications were found eligible and two applications were sanctioned for loan by the banks.
- (b) The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying has been taking various steps to cover maximum beneficiaries. Some of the steps taken by the Departments to popularize the scheme are as under:
 - (i) Credit Guarantee fund trust for Animal Husbandry & Dairying (CGFTAHD) has been established and Funds of Rs 109.00 crore were released during two years.
 - (ii) Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for Banks issued and uploaded on portal.
 - (iii) Model DPR's for Cattle feed unit/ Silage manufacturing unit and dairy product manufacturing unit uploaded on portal for facilitation of entrepreneurs.
 - (iv) Inclusion of Breed improvement technology and Breed Multiplication farm as an additional category- Establishment of IVF Centers, Sex sorted semen facility and Breed Multiplication farm

(v) To provide the hand holding at the grass root level, Common Service Centre has been integrated with AHIDF portal.

(vi) Guidelines have been translated into 13 languages.

(vii) The documentary has been made in 13 languages.

(viii) Meeting with the Banks has been held along with DFS on the pending applications.

(ix) Credit Extension & Publicity Division of Department of Animal Husbandry Department, as part of “AzadiKaAmritmahotsav” has organized a webinar on "Easy credit availability to livestock and dairy farmers under AtmaNirbhar Bharat Abhiyan through “Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund”.

(x) An Awareness Webinar has been taking place with the potential Beneficiaries like Individuals/ Farmers Producer Organizations, MSME etc.

(c) With the efforts made by the Department of Animal Husbandry, the achievement made so far is as under:
