Funds Allocated under PMMSY to Andhra Pradesh

1292. SHRIMATI CHINTA ANURADHA:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

- (a) the total funds allocated under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) to the State of Andhra Pradesh during the last two years and the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to set up Integrated Modern Coastal Fishing Villages in the State of Andhra Pradesh under this scheme in the current financial year; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing a flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) - A scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India with an investment of Rs.20050 crore for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21 for development of fisheries in all States/Union Territories including Andhra Pradesh. During the financial year 2020-21, the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has accorded approval to the proposal of Government of Andhra Pradesh at a total cost of Rs.275.60 crore with central share of Rs.79.566 crore under the PMMSY. The PMMSY *inter-alia* envisages setting up Integrated Modern Coastal Fishing Villages in the marine States/UTs including in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The Government of Andhra Pradesh has proposed for setting up three Integrated Modern Coastal Fishing Villages in the State during current financial year (2021-22).
