- (c) the details of the fund sanctioned for the development of the Animal Husbandry in the budgetary allocation 2020 & how much percentage of fund is released/expend to the State Government of West Bengal till now; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) The details of schemes implemented by the Government for development of animal husbandry in various States/UTs of the country, including the State of West Bengal during the last six years, are as under:
 - I. Rashtriya Gokul Mission(RGM)
 - II. National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)
 - III. National Dairy Plan-I(NDP-I) (was closed on 29 Nov, 2019. No financial assistance was released during 2019-20)
 - IV. Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme (DEDS)(discontinued from 2020-21)
 - V. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund(DIDF)
 - VI. Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDC&FPO)

- VII. National Livestock Mission(NLM)
- VIII. Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund(AHIDF)
- IX. Livestock Health & Disease Control(LH&DC)
- X. National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP)
- XI. Livestock Census and Integrated Sample Survey
- (b) Recently, Government has revised and realigned some of the components of the following existing schemes in order to have focussed development of animal husbandry and dairying across the country in the next 5 years starting 2021-22.

^{**}There was no State-Wise budgetary allocation during the year 2020 under NLM as no proposals was received from State Government of West Bengal and hence no fund was released to the state. However, during the last 6 years (from 2016-17), a total fund of Rs.1294.70 lakhs has been released to the State of West Bengal under NLM.

[#] Under NADCP, there is no state-wise allocation but funds are released to States/UTs on basis of action plan received from States/UTs.
