FUNDS FOR FPI SCHEMES IN BIHAR

†1370. **SHRI DILESHWAR KAMAIT:**

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds released to the State of Bihar under different Food Processing Industries (PLIs) schemes the district-wise;
- (b) whether funds released under above mentioned schemes have been utilized for the concerned schemes;
- (c) if so, the details of the schemes of whose work has been completed or is near its completion; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

**(a) to (d):** The Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) is implementing a Central Sector umbrella scheme- Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) for overall growth and development of food processing sector of the country including of Bihar. PMKSY is not region or state specific but demand driven, with no state-wise fund allocation. So far, a total of 10 projects have been approved under component schemes of PMKSY in Bihar. The status of projects along with grants released to these projects is placed at **Annexure**.

MoFPI is also implementing Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLIS) for Food Processing sector with an outlay of Rs.10,900 Cr. The scheme has been approved on 31.03.2021 and is to be implemented over a period of six years. The scheme is targeted to facilitate expansion of food processing capacity by creating champion brands in Food Processing Sector and there is no state-wise allocation of fund under this scheme.

As part of the Aatmanirbhar Bharat Initiative, MoFPI is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme-PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME) for providing financial, technical and business support for upgradation/ setting up of 2 lakh micro food processing enterprises during five years from 2020-21 to 2024-25 with an outlay of Rs.10,000 crore. Out of this, a total of 11,333 units have been allocated to Bihar with outlay of Rs 535.19 crore. So far, a total of Rs 9.56 Cr has been released to the state under the scheme.
