- (a) & (b): Phasing out of aircrafts and their replacement with new generation aircrafts depend upon national security, strategic objectives and operational requirements of the defence forces and is reviewed by the Government from time to time. This is a continuous process. The MiG series aircrafts follow the process of phasing out in a staggered manner on completion of their Total Calendar Life/Total Technical Life.
- (c) & (d): The delivery of 36 Rafale aircraft is proceeding as per schedule. As on date, a total of 26 aircraft have been accepted and ferried to India.
