TELECOM TOWERS IN THE VILLAGES

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages in the rural areas of the country where telecommunication towers have been set up during each of the last two years and the current year, State/UT-wise and telecom company-wise; and
- (b) the number of such towers targeted to be set up in the rural areas in the next financial year, State/UTwise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) Sir, the total number of villages in the rural areas of the country where telecommunication towers were installed during each of the last two years and the current year, State/UT-wise and telecom company-wise is attached as **Annexure-1**.
- (b) Telecom companies explore opportunities to expand their network coverage by installing new towers. The number of mobile towers in India has increased from 4,15,724 (as on 31-12-2015) to 6,63,411 (in 22-07-2021). Expansion of mobile towers is dynamic in nature and undertaken by the Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) and Infrastructure Providers Category-1 (IP-1) based on their CAPEX capacity, techno-commercial assessment and other parameters. Telecom Companies for most of the States/ UTs have expressed their inability to provide their future plan. However, for some of the States/ UTs they have provided number of towers proposed to be installed in rural areas in the next financial year which is attached as **Annexure-2**.

In addition to the above, Government has taken up following schemes to provide mobile/broadband/internet services in future by installation of towers in rural and remote areas of the country with support from Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF):

- i. Provision of 4G mobile services by installation of 2,542 towers in Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected areas under Phase-II.
- ii. Provision of 4G Mobile Services in uncovered villages of Meghalaya and seamless coverage along National Highway by installation of 889 towers.
- iii. Provision of 4G Mobile Services in uncovered villages of Arunachal Pradesh and 2 Districts of Assam by installation of 1,511 towers:
- iv. Provision of Mobile Services by installation of towers in 225 uncovered villages under the scheme to cover 354 uncovered villages of Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Uttarakhand, Border area & other priority areas.
- v. Provision of 4G mobile connectivity by installation of 462 towers in 502 uncovered villages of Aspirational Districts in four States (namely Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh & Rajasthan).
- vi. Provision of 4G Mobile Coverage by installation of 124 towers in uncovered villages and seamless 4G Mobile coverage of National Highway in Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
