#### ASSESSMENT OF SCHEMES/PROGRAMMES

#### †1532. SHRI RAMCHARAN BOHRA:

Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made/proposes to make any assessment regarding important big schemes/programmes in the country including in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the funds allocated for various schemes/ programmes during the last three years;
- (d) whether the allocated fund is being utilized properly;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the action taken by the Government in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

(a) & (b). The Ministries/Departments of the Government of India conduct evaluation of the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS)/Central Sector (CS) schemes being implemented by them. The NITI Aayog also conducts concurrent evaluation of the selected programmes/schemes. Besides this, in States/UTs, the State Evaluation Offices (SEOs) conduct evaluations of their prominent schemes/programmes. Continuation of Central Sector (CS)/Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) from one Finance Commission cycle to another entails a third party impact evaluation. For the continuation of Central Sector (CS) / Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) in 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Cycle, the Department of Expenditure in March 2019 entrusted Development Monitoring & Evaluation Office (DMEO), NITI Aayog to conduct evaluation of 28 Umbrella Centrally Sponsored Schemes comprising 125 CSS in selected sample States/UTs including Rajasthan. The list of Evaluation Studies of 28 Umbrella Centrally Sponsored Schemes

(UCSS) is enclosed in <u>Annexure-I.</u> The evaluation Reports have been shared with respective Ministries/Departments and Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance. The evaluation of CS Schemes was entrusted to respective Ministries/Departments.

**(c) to (f).** The respective Ministries/Departments implement the schemes in co-ordination with States/UTs. Further, they release funds to States/Implementing agencies from time to time and also monitor the schemes. Based on the findings and insights from evaluation studies, respective Ministries/Departments make mid-course corrections in the schemes.
