INDUSTRIAL NODES IN MAHARASHTRA

1538. SHRI VINAYAK RAUT:

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state: वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री

- (a) the places identified for development as industrial nodes or cities in Maharashtra under different Industrial Corridors:
- (b) the status of proposed industrial nodes above, their investment and employment potential;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The status of industrial nodes identified in the state of Maharashtra are as under:

1. <u>Shendra Bidkin Industrial Area (SBIA) under Delhi Mumbai Industrial</u> Corridor (DMIC)

(a)Shendra Industrial Area

Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) i.e. Aurangabad Industrial Township Limited has been incorporated. State Government has transferred the entire 8.39 sq kms of land to the SPV and matching equity of Rs. 602.80 Crore has been released by Government of India (GoI) through National Industrial Corridor Development and Implementation Trust (NICDIT). Major trunk infrastructure works have been completed. 93 plots have been allotted including allotment of 100 acres to anchor investor i.e., HYOSUNG a South Korean company. An investment of over Rs. 6,500 crore has been attracted in this area. The project was dedicated to the nation by Hon'ble PM on 7th September 2019.

(b) Bidkin Industrial Area -

Out of total 32 sq. kms, State Govt. has transferred land admeasuring 28.8 sq. kms and matching equity of Rs. 2397.20 Crore was also released by Gol through NICDIT. Trunk infrastructure works are nearing completion.

As per Development Plan, employment generation potential for SBIA is approximately 7.5 lakhs (Direct & Indirect).

2. Dighi Industrial Area under DMIC:

State Government has confirmed availability of 2,402 Ha (5,935 acres) of land, out of which 1,466 Ha (3,622 acres) is in possession of State Government. Detailed master planning and preliminary engineering for the land parcels have been initiated.

As per the Development Plan, employment generation potential for Dighi Industrial Area is approximately 3.2 lakhs (Direct & Indirect).

3. Satara node under Bengaluru Mumbai Industrial Corridor (BMIC) -

In March 2021, State Government of Maharashtra has confirmed the availability of 5,000 Ha land at Satara for development of industrial node. Out of which 314.06 Ha land is in possession of State Government. Tender document for selection of consultant for Detailed Master Planning and Preliminary Engineering has been issued.
