STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1603 BY SHRI VE. VAITHILINGAM TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 28.07.2021 REGARDING STATUS OF RAIL LINK FROM KARAIKAL-PERALAM
(a): Karaikal is already connected with Railway network including with Peralam via Nagappattinam, Tiruvarur. To provide additional direct connectivity from Karaikal to Peralam, 23 Km long new line work was sanctioned as material modification to Tiurchchirapalli Thanjavur - Nagore - Karaikal Gauge Conversion project at a cost of ₹177.69 crore in January, 2019. Land acquisition proposals for 3.20 Ha land have been submitted to State Government of Tamil Nadu in September, 2019. Government of Tamil Nadu has been requested to expedite land acquisition. However, work has been taken up on available land.
(b): Completion of a Railway project depends on various factors like expeditious land acquisition by State Government, shifting of infringing utilities, statutory clearances from various authorities, geological and topographical conditions of area, law and order situation in the area of project site, number of working months in a year for particular project site etc. and all these factors affect the completion time of project. As such, confirm completion time of the project cannot be ascertained at this stage.
