**PIPED WATER CONNECTIONS IN MAHARASHTRA**

1627. SHRI VINAYAK RAUT:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the target set for piped water connection to be provided in Maharashtra;
- (b) the time by which the target is going to be achieved; and
- (c) the achievement made so far?

(a) to (c) As on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2019, at the time of launch of Jal Jeevan Mission, in Maharashtra, out of 142.36 lakh rural households, 48.44 lakh households (34%) had piped water connections. Since then, 43.63 lakh households (30.65%) have been provided tap water connections, thus increasing the tap water supply to 92.07 lakh households (64.67%). Remaining 50.329 lakhs rural households are planned to be provided with tap water connection by 2024.
