- (a) the status of Jagdishpur-Haldia Gas pipeline project;
- (b) the tentative timeline for supply of CNG for the city of Kolkata; and
- (c) the plans and timeline for supplying piped cooking gas in Kolkata?

(a) Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) has authorized 2,655 Km long Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra Natural Gas Pipeline (JHBDPL) to GAIL (India) Limited to connect eastern parts of the country. About 1,986 Km of pipeline has been laid as on 31.03.2021.

(b) & (c) Bengal Gas Company Limited (BGCL) has been authorized for the development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) network in the Geographical Area (GA) of Kolkata Municipal Corporation and parts adjoining districts of North 24 Parganas, South 24 Parganas, Howrah, Hooghly and Nadia. Supply of Natural Gas to the GA has started. Development of the CNG stations /PNG connections in a GA is done as per the terms and conditions of the authorization.
