ROAD PROJECTS IN NAGALAND

1689. SHRI TOKHEHO YEPTHOMI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the approved road projects from 2018 to March 2021 in the State of Nagaland which are of economic importance and those having inter-state connectivity also including those which are covered under Central Road and Infrastructure Fund (CRIF), location-wise;**
- (b) the estimated cost of these projects; and**
- (c) the funds allocated and utilized for these projects during the said period?**

ANSWER

(a) to (b): During the period April, 2018 to March, 2021, one work of Construction of Intermediate lane road from Yongnyah EAC Hq. to 186MW Dikhu Hydro Project, having length 22 Km at a cost of Rs. 74.06 crore was sanctioned under Economic Importance scheme on 30.01.2019. In addition, 30 works for a length of 605 Km amounting to Rs 6018 crore have been sanctioned under NH(O), SARDP-NE and Bharatmala Scheme during the above said period in the State of Nagaland.

(c) The funds are not allocated project wise, the same are allocated State-wise. The details of funds allocated for all ongoing EI works and expenditure incurred for the above said sanctioned work in the State of Nagaland are as under:
