EXPANSION OF INDORE AIRPORT

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION लागर विमालन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

(a) whether the Government has any plan for expansion of Indore airport;

(b) if so, the time frame of the Government and if not, the reasons therefor;

(c) whether the Government plans to construct a separate international terminal at Indore airport or to convert it into a terminal for international air travel; and

(d) if so, the time by which it will be constructed?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्रातय में राज्य मंत्री (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

- (a): The Airports Authority of India (AAI) has projected a land requirement of 2314.52 acre for expansion/development of Indore airport to make it suitable for Code-E type of aircraft operations. The expansion/development project includes extension of existing runway, parallel runway and other allied work.
- (b): The development of the airport is subject to the provision of land by the State Govt. of Madhya Pradesh free of cost and free from all encumbrances to AAI.
- (c) & (d): The existing terminal building at the airport is an Integrated Terminal Building suitable for both Domestic and International operations. At present, there is no plan to construct new terminal building by AAI.
