(a) to (c): Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA), Delhi is currently having three runways and M/s Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) has initiated construction of fourth runway as per Master Plan 2016 of IGIA. Presently, under Master Plan 2016, no further runways are planned to be developed in the subsequent phases.
