GREEN FREIGHT CORRIDOR

1838. SHRI MAGUNTA SREENIVASULU REDDY:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plans to launch a Green Freight Corridor to improve coastal trading along the Eastern coast; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER FOR PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) No Sir. However efforts are being made to make coastal shipping more economical and effective
- (b) The steps taken to promote coastal shipping includes:
 - (i) licensing relaxation to foreign flag vessels for carrying trans-shipment containers, empty containers, fertilizers and agricultural, fisheries, animal husbandry and horticultural commodities on coastal routes;
 - (ii) minimum 40% discount is offered by major ports on vessel and cargo related charges to coastal vessels;
 - (iii) prioritization in berthing of coastal ships at major ports, subsidy to Indian flagged vessels for carrying Public Sector Units' cargo; and
 - (iv) GST Reduced on Bunker Fuel from 18% to 5%
